

Musical Conversation with Roderick Williams OBE Monday 8 March 2021 at 5pm



Continuing his series of musical conversations with musicians associated with the Club, Richard Price talks to the English Baritone Roderick Williams who gave a song recital at the Club a few years ago.

Richard talks to Roderick about his musical life from his time as a choral scholar in Oxford and a music teacher in London to his decision to study opera at The Guildhall and his subsequent professional career as a soloist on the concert platform, a lieder singer, an opera singer and a composer.

The talk will be interspersed with extracts from some of Roderick's many recordings including his new record of Schubert's "Wintereisse"; a duet from Benjamin Britten's Opera "Peter Grimes"; one of his own compositions and part of his famous appearance at "The Last night of the Proms".
