


Literature Table with Michael Billington, O.B.E

Subject: Harold Pinter Tuesday 12 September 2023

The Literature Table is designed for members of the Club, particularly those who took degrees in English, to enjoy an evening of dinner-table conversation about literature, but is open to anyone interested in the subject matter.



Michael Billington, who read English at St Catherine's College, Oxford, of which he is now an honorary fellow, was the chief drama critic of The Guardian from 1971 until 2019. He has written widely on the theatre, including studies of Peggy Ashcroft, Tom Stoppard and Alan Ayckbourn, as well as the official authorised biography of this evening's subject, Harold Pinter, the winner of the 2005 Nobel Prize for Literature. He has also directed productions of Pinter's plays.

Mr Billington's book *State of the Nation: British Theatre since 1945* won the 2007 Theatre Book Prize from the Society for Theatre Research.
